

FRESH START HOUSING

Referral Partner Guide

A stable bridge for clients transitioning out of incarceration, inpatient treatment, or crisis. Fresh Start Housing pairs transitional housing with a 15-month, individualized financial literacy program.

WHO WE ACCEPT

- Ages 20 to 50 (age waivers considered case-by-case)
- Working with the Department of Correction before discharge
- Referred through probation or parole
- In recovery with 90 days of sobriety following discharge
- Enrolled in a titration program as part of medication-assisted treatment

Clients do not need to be homeless or facility-discharged to qualify. We do not accept couples, and residents may not keep pets.

ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS

- Full-time employment (40 hrs/week), or part-time (30 hrs/week) paired with full-time schooling
- Full participation in the 15-month program
- Weekly attendance at the financial literacy class
- 10% of all earnings placed into a personal savings account
- Maintained sobriety throughout the program
- Continued engagement with existing outside treatment or support providers

HOW TO REFER A CLIENT

Call to schedule an introduction and interview appointment. Clients who are incarcerated or in treatment and unable to travel can be interviewed by Zoom. We ask that clients take responsibility for scheduling the appointment themselves.
